"Flu is Raging, Get Vaccinated Quickly" Joint appeal to parents, children, pregnant women, chronically ill or elderly people and their caregivers by The Hong Kong Paediatric Society, The Macau Pediatric Society, The Hong Kong Chinese Medical Association Ltd., The Hong Kong Society for Paediatric Immunology Allergy and Infectious Diseases, The Hong Kong Society for Infectious Diseases, Dr Hon David LAM Tzit-yuen, Member of the Legislative Council (Healthcare), Hon Chan Hoi-yan, Member of the Legislative Council (Election Committee), The Obstetrical and Gynaecological Society of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Geriatric Society, The Association of Licentiates of Medical Council of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Paediatric and Adolescent Dermatology Society, The College of Nursing Hong Kong, The Hong Kong College of Paediatric Nursing, The Hong Kong Paediatric Nurses Association, Asian Medical Expert Academy, The Hong Kong Midwives Association and The Hong Kong School Nurse Association Ltd.

The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and the Macau Special Administrative Region are facing the threat of ongoing seasonal influenza viruses' infections in the community. What is worse is that new variants of the COVID-19 are also continuing to infect Hong Kong and Macau residents. **High-risk individuals are the first to be affected**. It is necessary for the public to enhance their awareness of prevention against seasonal influenza and COVID-19.

High-risk groups (including infants, young children, pregnant women, the elderly, and people with chronic diseases) are prone to severe illness, hospitalization, and even intensive care unit admission, and some unfortunately died after being infected with the influenza virus. Children have frequent social contacts and group activities in school, which can easily disseminate respiratory viruses (including influenza viruses), in schools and in the community, and it is well recognized that they can also bring the virus back home to infect high-risk individuals.

Acute Necrotizing Encephalitis is a serious neurological condition because of the viral invasion into the central nervous system and the subsequent inflammatory response it triggered. The symptoms include seizures, disturbance of consciousness with rapid deterioration and patients may rapidly progress to a coma status and death. Even patients may fortunately be recovered, there will be extensive multiple organ damage and life-long neurological deficits, which requires prolonged treatment and rehabilitation therapy.



It is absolutely necessary for high-risk individuals to receive seasonal influenza vaccination to prevent severe illness and hospitalization after influenza virus infection. Vaccination can also greatly reduce mortality or the sequelae even after recovery.

Infants, young children, and teenagers are not only important members of every family, but also the main pillars of the future of our society. We absolutely care and value the

precious value of every child and have the responsibility to protect their health and enable them to thrive. Parents and caregivers should value the benefit of vaccination from a scientific perspective, vaccination is to protect the health and lives of infants, young children and adolescents. **Scientific data has proved that seasonal influenza vaccines and COVID-19 vaccines are clinically very effective**, and serious adverse vaccine reactions are quite rare. Therefore, parents, pregnant women, chronically ill or elderly people and their caregivers need not to worry. We sincerely appeal to parents and caregivers should no longer hesitate and to vaccinate infants, young children and adolescents with the 2023/24 seasonal influenza vaccine and complete the COVID-19 vaccination* as soon as possible to prevent the current epidemic of influenza and COVID-19, "Twindemic". You can be reassured that the flu vaccine and the COVID-19 vaccine can be given at the same time. If you have any questions, please consult your family doctor. In addition, the public should also maintain good personal and environmental hygiene habits.

If children and teenagers suffer from influenza, COVID-19 and various respiratory virus infections, you can refer to the following recommendation in the reference "Caring for Children and Adolescents with Seasonal Influenza, COVID-19 and Respiratory Viruses Infections at Home and Their Prevention¹ " issued by Dr Hon David LAM Tzit-yuen, Member of the Legislative Council (Healthcare) and thirteen Hong Kong and Macau medical and nursing societies and the online talk "Influenza is Raging - How can Parents and Caregivers Prevent and Manage Influenza Infections in Children?²" on the official YouTube channel of the Center for Health Protection of the Department of Health.

We hope that the general public will be aware of the harmful effects of "Twindemic" or Tridemic" attacks on themselves and their families. Dr. Hon David LAM Tzit-yuen, Member of the Legislative Council (Healthcare), Hon Chan Hoi-yan, Member of the Legislative Council (Election Committee) and fifteen medical and nursing societies from Hong Kong and Macau would like to issue this joint appeal to parents, children, pregnant women, chronically ill or elderly people and their caregivers, "The Flu is Raging, Get Vaccinated Quickly." We also hope that the health authorities, health professionals and the media will contribute more efforts to promote and promulgate vaccine information to the general public.
